I don't mind camping but the novelty wears off after a couple of weeks, and being the wet season..... well I don't have to tell you about camping in the rain. Rob Jordan and I all feel confident that the house is a sign from God telling us not to worry about where we will live, and what we will have, God is able to provide and we have experienced this first hand.
